We will do very little movement for the August match. I have made set up and hopefully tear down, as simple as possible, but we still want some fun, Right?

“Cracker Cowboy” attire

Once again “Cracker Cowboy” attire will be allowed now until October. (If desired, shorts are ok now for both men and women. For Men: preferably, short sleeve button style shirts plain or western or a “Henley” with cut-off sleeves; if all else fails T-shirts OK, just not preferred. Foot Attire for all: leather sandals or short boots, or “*reasonably period correct*” short shoes (1860-1900) You may wear a hat, or no hat, your choice anyway in SASS. I always find a straw hat to keep sun out of my eyes helps, along with an ice cold bandana either on the head, or neck or both! Of course, if you prefer the normal cowboy attire, that is always OK. The Mexican style peon clothing is lightweight and relatively cool. Ladies are always allowed short sleeve or sleeveless period correct or saloon girl attire. (Lucky Ladies of Florida!)

Thank you so much to all of you who help set up and tear down. It is so very much appreciated! This month, **please bring your own lunch or snacks** to munch on either during the match or during the scores. Please **be sure to stay hydrated**. We will have bottle water in the ice coolers. 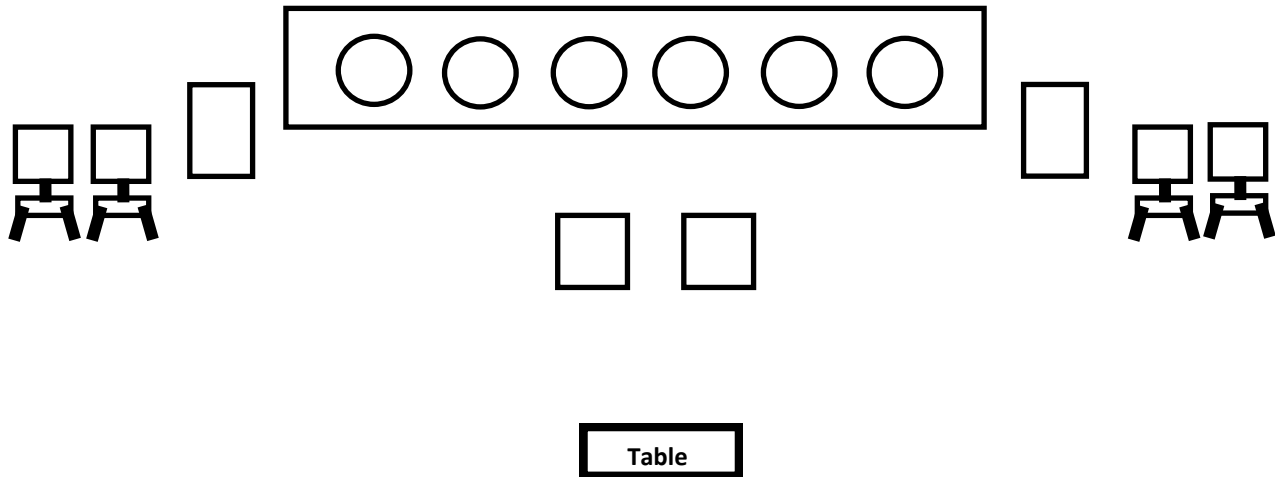

Targets, Stands, Tables

- 2 Rectangles
- 2 Mid Stands
- 2 Squares
- 2 Short Stands
- 1 Large Table
- 4 Shotgun Knockdowns
- 1 Plate Rack

Stage 1 Bay E August 2023 DL

Rawhide Tribute Match



Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun.

Directions: **Shotgun** and **Rifle** on Table. **Pistols** holstered. Start with hands on **Pistols**.

Procedure: When shooter is ready state your line “Gil Favor’s my name, I’m the Trail Boss!”

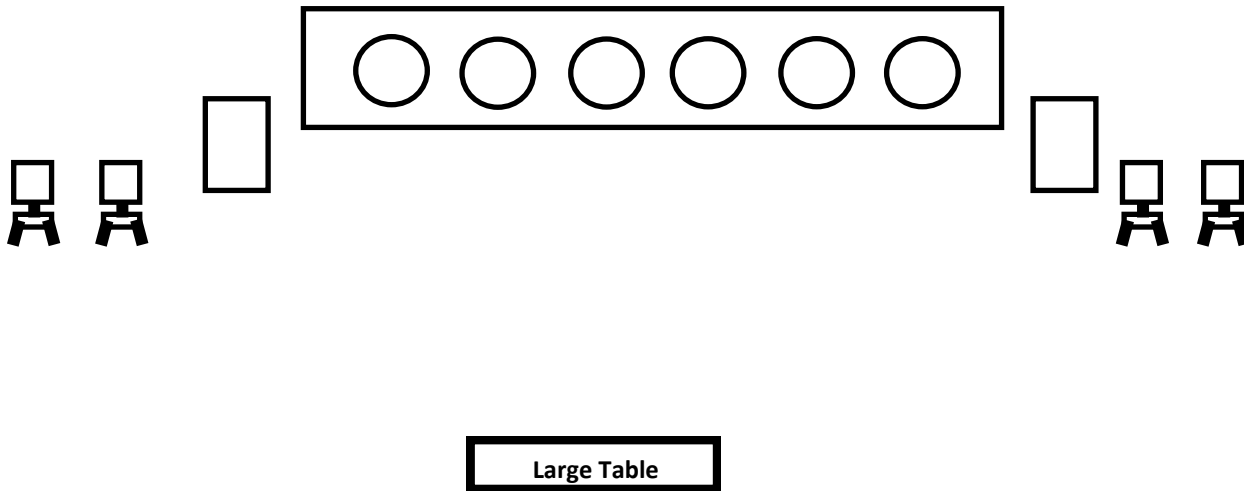
ATB – Guns may be shot in any order, as long as the **Rifle** is not last. With **Pistols**, starting from either side, shoot 2 on one of the squares and eight on the other square. With **Rifle** repeat **Pistol** instructions on the rectangles. Shoot knockdowns with **Shotgun** until down. After all guns have been fired, you may make up **Pistol** and/or **Rifle** misses made by shooting the number of misses on the plate rack with the **Shotgun**, up to six misses total. Misses on plate rack do not count.

Stage 2, Bay E August 2023 DL

Rawhide Tribute Match

Targets, Stands, Tables

- 1 Plate Rack
- 2 Rectangles
- 2 Medium Stands
- 4 Shotgun Targets
- 1 Large Table



Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun.

Directions: **Pistols** holstered. **Rifle** staged on table. **Shotgun** on table.

Shooter starts behind table with hat in one hand waving at “cows.” Other hand on **Rifle**

Procedure: When shooter is ready state your line: “Head ‘em up....move ‘em out”

ATB – You may replace hat on head or drop it. Then with **Rifle**, knockdown plate rack plates. Remaining rounds should be placed on your choice of left or right rectangle targets.

Ground **Rifle**. Shooter’s choice of next gun order: **Pistols** or **Shotgun** next. With **Shotgun**, knockdown shotgun targets, then if there are remaining plates on plate rack, you may make those up after knockdowns are down. Ground **Shotgun**.

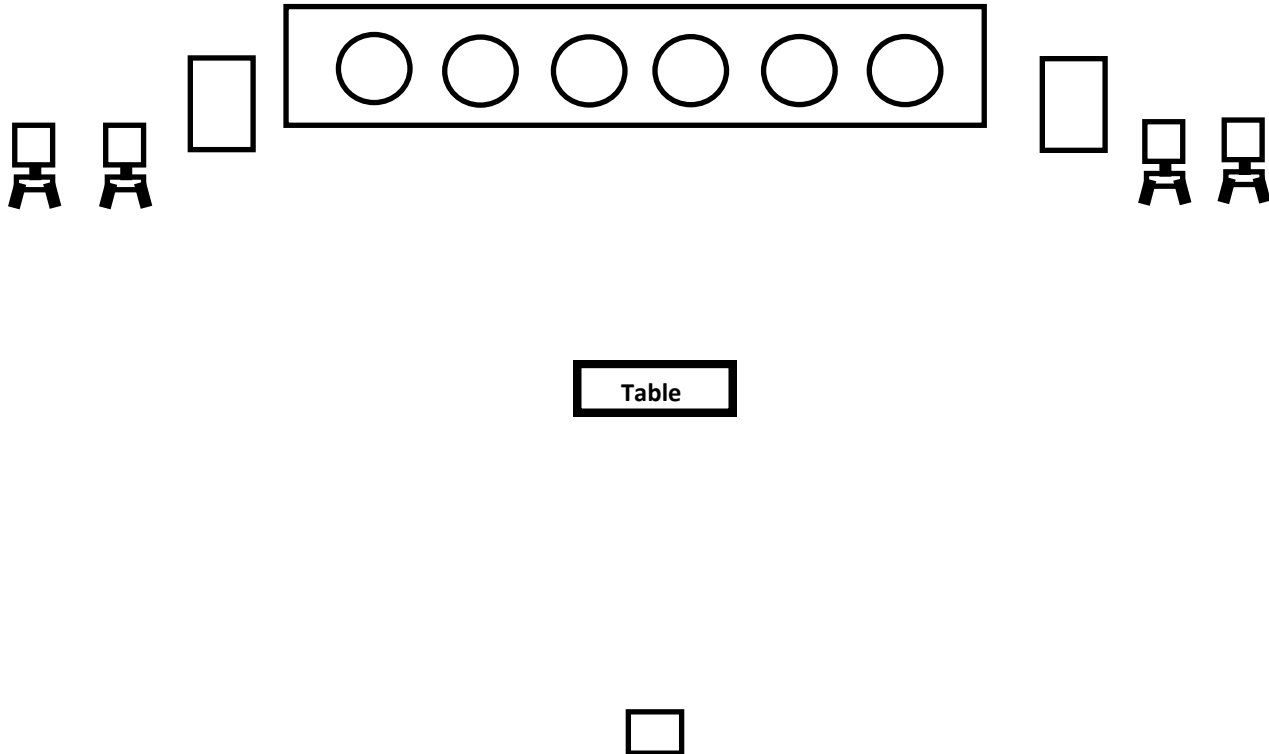
With **Pistols**, shoot five on each rectangle. Holster **Pistols**.

Stage 3 Bay E August 2023 DL

Rawhide Tribute Match

Targets, Stands, Tables

- 2 Rectangles
- 2 Mid Stands
- 4 Knockdowns
- 1 Large Table
- 1 Plate Rack
- 1 Start Plate



Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 6+ shotgun.

Directions: Shooter standing with at least part of one foot on start plate. **Rifle** in hand. **Shotgun** staged on table. **Pistols** staged on table.

Procedure: When shooter is ready, state your line: “Mushy, there is only one man the drive can’t do without!The Cook”

ATB – With **Rifle**, place six rounds on plate rack, then 4 rounds on **Shotgun** targets. Move to table and ground **Rifle**. Next gun is shooters choice. With **Pistols**, dump ten shots on either rectangle. Ground or holster **Pistols**. With **Shotgun**, clean up any shotgun targets and/or plates still standing. Ground **Shotgun**.

1 Rectangles

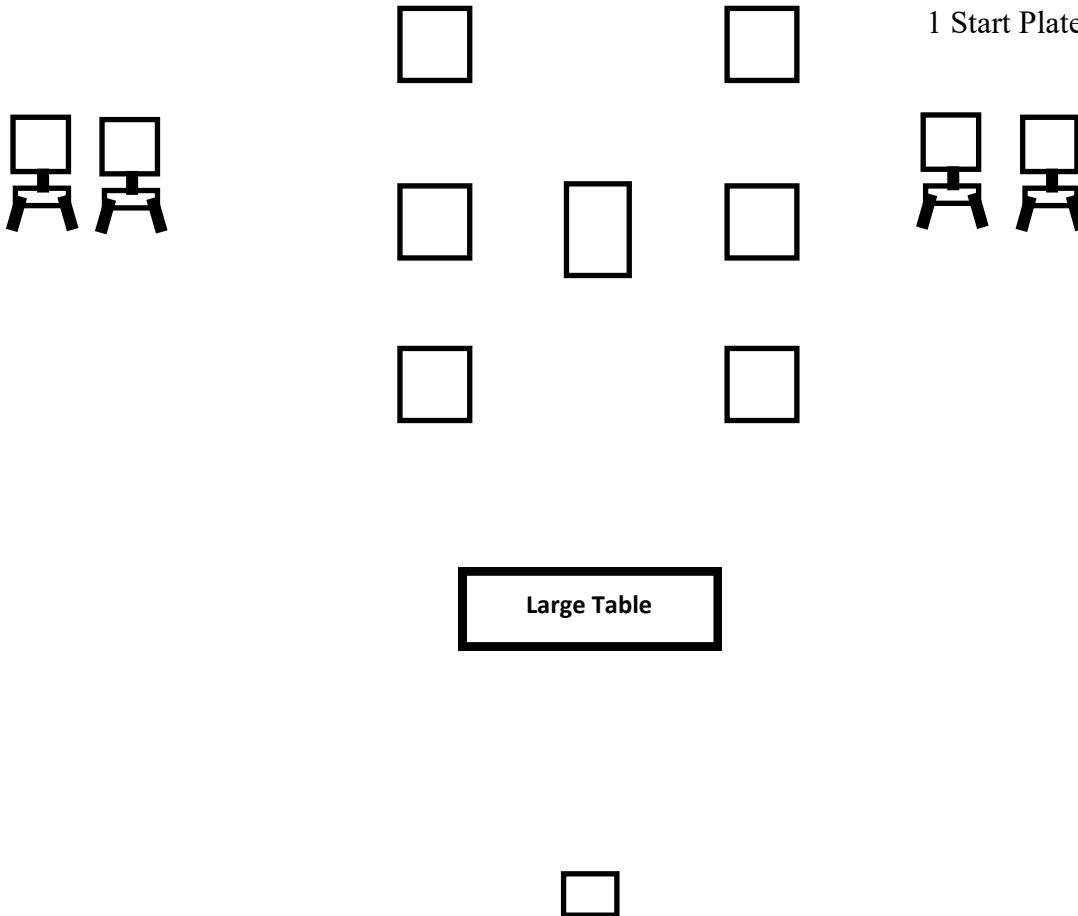
3 Tall Stands

6 Squares

4 Knockdowns

1 Large Table

1 Start Plate



Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun.

Directions: **Shotgun** and **Pistols** staged on large table

Shooter begins with at least part of one foot on start plate, **Rifle** in hand.

Procedure: When shooter is ready state your line: “On a trail drive, each and every man has a chore”

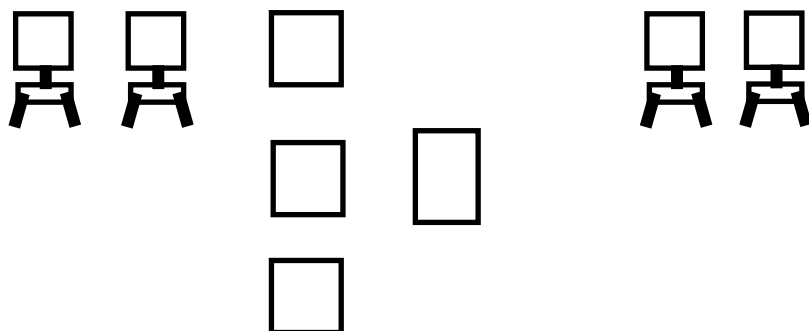
ATB – With **Rifle** starting on either side of squares, from top to bottom, shoot three squares then shoot two rounds on rectangle. Repeat instructions on the squares on the other side and then place two on the rectangle. Move to table. Ground **Rifle**. **Shotgun** or **Pistols** next. With **Pistols**, starting on either side of squares, repeat **Rifle** instructions. Ground or holster **Pistols**. With **Shotgun** knock down shotgun targets in any order. Ground **Shotgun**.

Stage 5 Bay F August 2023 MM

Targets, Stands, Tables

- 3 Squares
- 2 Tall Stands
- 1 Rectangle
- 1 Large Table
- 4 Shotgun Targets

Large Table

Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4+ shotgun.

Directions: **Rifle** and **Shotgun** staged on table. **Pistols** holstered. Shooter standing behind table with cup in both hands.

Procedure: When shooter is ready state your line: “Nothin’ like a hot cup of coffee before gettin’ on the trail”

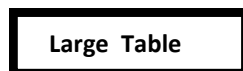
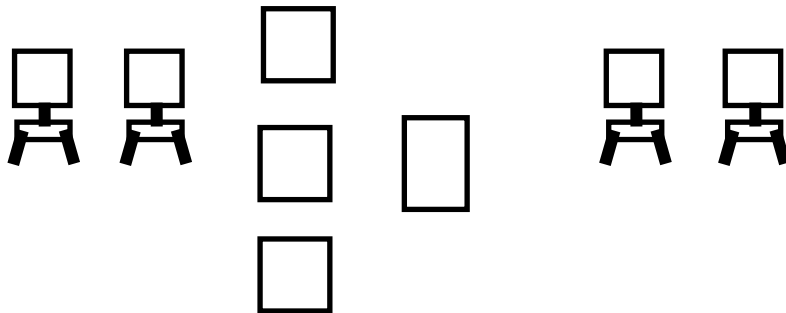
ATB – Drop the cup. Shooters choice of gun sequence as long as **Rifle** is not last. With **Rifle**, single tap a square, then double tap the rectangle. Repeat 2 times. Each square must be hit at least once. Place last round on any square. Ground **Rifle**. With **Pistols**, repeat the **Rifle** instructions Holster **Pistols**. With **Shotgun** engage shotgun targets until down. Ground **Shotgun**.

Stage 6 Bay F August 2023 MM

Targets, Stands, Tables

3 Squares
2 Tall Stands
1 Rectangle
4 Knockdowns
1 Large Table

Round Count: 10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun.

Directions: **Rifle** and **Shotgun** staged on table. **Pistols** holstered. Both hands flat on table.

Procedure: When shooter is ready state your line: "Move the herd over the pass, Rowdy"

ATB – With **Shotgun**, engage knockdowns in pairs, left pair first, then right pair until down. You must pick up shotgun targets on left before moving to the right. Ground **Shotgun**. With **Rifle**, sweep squares from top to bottom twice and then place 4 rounds on rectangle. Ground **Rifle**. With **Pistols** repeat the **Rifle** instructions. Holster **Pistols**.

Rawhide Tribute Match August 2023

For those of you who might care:

Rawhide was a T.V. series from 1959 to 1965. One of my personal favorite T.V. shows growing up, it served as a start up role for our famous and beloved Clint Eastwood, starring as the young Rowdy Yates. Gil Favor, portrayed by Eric Fleming, was the trail boss. And the quirky cook, Wishbone, portrayed by Paul Brinegar, was always giving his goofy assistant, Mushy (James Murdock) a rough time.

The show was based on the story of a trailboss, and his drovers moving cattle from Texas to Missouri. The episodes surround many troubles and triumph themes along the way. The timeline is set in the 1860's after the civil war. There are saloon adventures, robbers, murderers and other evil doers as they make there tough trail to deliver the cattle. Always looking for water for the men and the cattle, such a scarce commodity was a constant worry for all. Throw in bad thunderstorms and stampeding cattle, the adventures were endless. It was a relatively realistic portrayal of cowboy life in the 1860's, especially for the time of it's filming.
